AREA CONTRACTOR, MAC CONSTRUCTION & EXCAVATING, INC., FIRST TO EARN NATIONAL AWARD FOR EXCELLENCE IN CONSTRUCTION

New Albany, Indiana (April 28, 2011) - MAC Construction & Excavating, Inc. (MAC) earned the prestigious National Eagle Award as part of the Associated Builders & Contractors Excellence in Construction Awards ceremony for its work on the Warnock Interchange and Eastern Parkway Improvements project in Louisville, KY. In this case, that involved MAC, the Kentucky Transportation Cabinet, the University of Louisville and URS Corporation. The winning projects, selected from entries submitted from across the nation, were judged on complexity, attractiveness, unique challenges overcome, completion time, workmanship, innovation, safety and cost.

A panel of industry experts served as the competition's judges. This year's panel included representatives from the Design-Build Institute of America, *Engineering News-Record*, the American Institute of Architects, and the National Association of Women in Construction, and representatives from higher education, among others.
